

Call for Applications

Spring Internship Programme 2022

The National Maritime Foundation (NMF) is delighted to invite individuals who are interested in **maritime** studies to apply for the Spring 2022 Edition of its much sought-after series of internship programmes.

The NMF's internships are unique in many ways. As always, our interns will get to engage in a well-coordinated and meaningful platform that is a carefully-planned voyage through the maritime domain. These internships will be conducted entirely in an **OFFLINE (PHYSICAL)** mode.

1. LOCATION

New Delhi

2. DURATION

Based upon experience and feedback received from previous interns, the NMF is offering two optional variants for its Spring Internship, *each of which will be conducted entirely in the English language*.

a. "SPRINGTERN-22"

This is the first variant on offer and will be of **three months' duration**. It will **terminate on Friday, 13 April 2022.** SPRINGTERN-22 interns who wish to extend their tenure to six months would be allowed to do so, subject to a satisfactory performance-review by the NMF.

b. "SPRINGEX-22"

This is the second variant on offer and will be of **six-months duration**. "SPRINGEX-22" will **terminate on 15 July 2022**. *Interns of this variant will be offered a modest stipend*.

3. ELIGIBILITY

All Candidates who have **completed**:

- a. The first year of their Bachelor's program (in any subject)
- b. Master's and above (in any subject)

However, candidates pursuing internships at other organisations are ineligible.

Preference (for both variants) will be given to those with *higher* academic qualifications and/or work-experience

4. PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

What each aspirant for the **"Spring Internship Programme 2022"** should expect from the NMF, and, what the NMF expects in turn, are detailed in the NMF's Website, which each aspirant is strongly encouraged to carefully and diligently peruse.

- a. There will be a common foundational segment orienting ALL interns (SPRINGTERN-22 and SPRINGEX-22) to the maritime domain. The approximate duration of this segment is SIX WEEKS. This will comprise a daily set of intensive high-quality lectures cum presentations, conducted personally by our <u>Director General, Vice Admiral Pradeep</u> <u>Chauhan (Retd)</u>, as also by experienced members of the <u>Research Faculty</u> from 1000 hours to 1700 hours (Monday to Friday) and from 1000 hours to 1300 hours on Saturdays. This segment is akin to a teaching capsule.
- b. During the foundational segment, apart from imbibing the fundamentals of the maritime domain, interns will be tasked with writing critiques and book reviews relevant to the maritime domain. Both legal interns as well as International Relations interns will be given book reviews/critiques, appropriate to their background.
- c. In the remaining period of the internship, interns of both variants would be tasked with:
 - i. **Data-mining:** Assist the NMF's Research Faculty in the collation of literature and the creation of data-sets
 - ii. **Content creation:** Generate content for the NMF's social media handles
 - iii. **Event management:** Assist the Conference Cell and the Marketing Team to organise and manage seminars, workshops and conferences
 - iv. Research: Submit ONE review of a book based on the maritime domain

a. A strict dress code is maintained throughout the internship for all candidates. Kindly check our dress code <u>here</u>.

b. Do **NOT** forget to specify the variant for which you are applying in the subject line of your e-mail

c. Please send us your CV in the format indicated in the Appendix. *Even if you have sent us an unsolicited request for internship along with your CV, please do so again, this time strictly in accordance with the Appendix*

d. You may attach a writing sample (published or unpublished)
